IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Before me, the undersigned Assistant District Attorney of Harris County, Texas, this day appeared the undersigned affiant, who under oath says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that in Harris County, Texas, **NICHOLAS MORALES**, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about **November 1, 2021**, did then and there unlawfully, without the effective consent of the owner, namely, without any consent of any kind, intentionally and knowingly enter a habitation owned by Laurie Alsobrooks, a person having title to the habitation and a greater right to possession of the habitation than the Defendant, and commit and attempt to commit the felony of Criminal Mischief.

Probable Cause

Your affiant, David Williamson is a peace officer with the Houston Police Department. Affiant has reason to believe, and does believe, Nicholas Morales, hereafter referred to as Defendant, committed the FELONY offense of BURGLARY OF A HABITATION on or about November 01, 2021 at 2706 Woodland Grove Dr. in Houston, Harris County, Texas.

Your affiant was assigned to investigate a case that has the elements to support Burglary of a Habitation, Houston Police case number 1477103-21 that was originally entered by Officer M. Pesses.

Your affiant learned from this report that on or near November 01, 2021, Laurie Alsobrooks, who your affiant believes to be reliable, credible and hereafter referred to as COMPLAINANT, discovered her house located at 2706 Woodland Grove Dr. in Houston, Harris County, Tx. to have been broken into and vandalized. The damages inside the residence totaled \$24,135.50. The complainant's residence was in the process of being sold and as a result was unoccupied.

Affiant obtained pictures documenting the damage from inside the residence. One of the pictures depicted a tie dye sweatshirt with the picture of "Tupac" (music artist) and with the words, "Poetic Justice" and "A Street Romance" written across the front. Through the course of investigation your affiant discovered a criminal mischief (HPD ORI# 1472280-21) that occurred on November 01, 2021 and was only a few blocks away from where this burglary occurred. Affiant was able to obtain surveillance video/pictures from this incident and observed one of the persons to be wearing a tie dye sweatshirt matching the same sweatshirt left at the complainant's residence.

On November 04, 2021, HPD Kingwood patrol officers responded to a suspicious person call (HPD ORI# 1486854-21) at the same house that was burglarized on November 01, 2021, 2706 Woodland Grove Dr. The defendant and juvenile co-defendant were detained for criminal trespassing and evading arrest. The defendant was arrested for these incidents and the juvenile co-defendant was released. Upon being released, your affiant obtained a recorded non-custodial statement from the juvenile co-defendant who admitted to being the person in the surveillance pictures/video wearing the tie dye sweatshirt. Affiant also determined the juvenile co-defendant was wearing the same shoes as was seen in the surveillance pictures/video. The juvenile co-defendant confessed to causing damage to the security window at the convenience store and then going to the 2706 Woodland Grove Dr. residence and vandalize the inside with the help of the defendant and another juvenile. The juvenile co-defendant confessed that his intent was to cause damage to the property.

Your affiant obtained a custodial statement from the defendant who also confessed to the criminal mischief and burglary. The defendant stated he ran away from home recently after getting in trouble at home and at school. The defendant confirmed the juvenile co-defendant was with him during these incidents. Affiant showed the defendant the surveillance pictures from this criminal mischief and he pointed himself out. The defendant stated they found an unlocked window at the 2706 Woodland Grove Dr. residence, entered the house and began destroying the house based off of what the pictures taken by the complainant depict.

Your affiant compared the surveillance pictures to the defendant Nicholas Moralez (TID: 15835611) and was able to positively identify him.
